Commemorate Stonewall with LGBTQ-Inclusive Sex Ed!

This month is the 50th anniversary of the [Stonewall uprising](#), which was a key turning point in the modern LGBTQ civil rights movement. Although much progress has been made since 1969, [less than 5%](#) of middle and high school students across the country reported having positive discussions of LGBT-related topics in their health classes. Compared to their straight and cisgender peers, LGBTQ youth are [less likely to use condoms or birth control](#) and are more likely to experience dating violence. LGBTQ-inclusive sex education helps youth get the information they need and deserve to stay safe and healthy.
